The 2020 Tang Prize in Sustainable Development.

It is our pleasure and honor to invite you to nominate scholars you deem most deserving of this Prize, according to the following criteria: *The Tang Prize in Sustainable Development recognizes those who have made extraordinary contributions to the sustainable development of human societies, especially through groundbreaking innovations in science and technology.*

The ideal candidate would be of a caliber deserving the most distinguished awards in the world, organization is also eligible. This Prize will grant a cash award of NT\$40 million (around US\$1.3 million), plus a NT\$10 million grant (around US\$320,000) for further amplification of the laureate's endeavors. Up to three laureates, if necessary, can share this award.

The Tang Prize was founded in 2012 with the mission to recognize and support groundbreaking research and developments of significance to humanity. The prize is awarded biennially in four major categories: *Sustainable Development, Biopharmaceutical Science, Sinology, and Rule of Law*. A separate selection committee is responsible for each award category and consists of approximately twenty world-leading experts to select the most deserving laureate(s). We request that you treat your nomination as **highly confidential**, and refrain from making known your nomination to anyone, including the nominee(s). Nominators shall not nominate himself/herself as a candidate or individuals who have passed away.
